

Program Options for a Visit to the Central Library

Drop-in (no staff-led program)

Drop-in to the library to browse our collections, play games, read books, and hang out. Group drop-ins are most successful when the group stays between 30 and 60 minutes in our space. Our desk staff can answer any questions and help you find material.

Storytime

Ages 0-5 (Pre-k) 30 minutes of stories, songs, and rhymes just for your group in our programming room. Adults are expected to stay in the room for the program.

Story Program

Grades K-4 A fun story and a craft or game just for your group. Story Programs are up to an hour and take place in our program room. Teachers and group leaders are expected to stay with their group for the duration of the program.

Book Talk

Grades 2-7 Hear about the coolest new books at the library to find your next great read! Library staff will choose books based on your group's age and interests and show them off so you can take them home! 30-45 minutes.

Library Skills

Grades 3-7 Personalized instruction beyond our [Library Skills Toolkit](#) You can visit the Central Library or a Children's Librarian can visit your class in-person or on Zoom. Please note any research topics you would like covered in the notes field. 45 to 60 minutes.

Research Project

Grades 2-7 Bring your class to the Central library to look at books and online resources they can use for their projects and papers. Please tell us which topics you are learning about. We will do our best to have enough material for your group. 30-60 minutes.
