Genealogy Workshops and Orientation Services

Over the past year, Library and Archives Canada (LAC) has continued to deliver workshops in several parts of B.C. including the Lower Mainland, Victoria, and Kelowna. The focus of these public programming activities has been to highlight the information found in LAC databases including genealogy, Indigenous genealogy and military heritage. These workshops aim to demonstrate the online resources available to the public and provide context to the records in various databases. At the LAC service point in the Vancouver Public Library, we provide orientation services to online databases including the 1926 Census of the Prairie Provinces, recently released. In addition, users can access Ancestry, FindMyPast and other commercial databases. Filipino Immigrants on the Pacific's Northwest Coast Speaker: Leonora C. Angeles, Professor, UBC Social Justice Institute Thursday, October 24, 2019 7:30 p.m.

Vancouver Historical Society Location: Museum of Vancouver 1100 Chestnut Street, Vancouver, B.C.

This presentation examines the post-war resettlement patterns of Filipino immigrants on the Pacific Northwest Coast of Canada and the United States. These resettlement patterns

have been shaped by the Philippines' colonial ties to the United States, its dense transnational economic ties since the 1980s with Canada, and the differing immigration policies and integration practices in the Pacific North West. The talk examines the historical and contemporary issues facing the full integration of the Filipino community into the multicultural landscape of Vancouver and demonstrates how and why Filipino immigrants are like "canaries in a coal mine" within the visible immigrant population of Metro Vancouver and Canada.

Leonora C. Angeles is cross-appointed faculty member at the University of British Columbia School of Community and Regional Planning and the Institute for Gender, Race, Sexuality and Social Justice. She volunteers for various Filipino-Canadian organizations such as the Daloy Puso youth mentoring network and also sits on the Board of the Erasga Dance Company and the University of the Philippines Alumni Association of British Columbia.

Against the Current: The Remarkable Life of Agnes Deans Cameron Guest Speaker: Cathy Converse Sunday, September 15, 2019 2:00 p.m.

Agnes Deans Cameron (1863-1912) was an author, journalist, educator, school trustee, sportswoman, orator, adventurer, and international celebrity. She was British Columbia's first female high school teacher and first school principal, and during her lifetime became one of Canada's most well-

known writers, publishing in the top international magazines and newspapers. Cameron stands as one of the top 150 most significant individuals in the history of the province of British Columbia.

Cathy Converse will share some of the funny incidents, discoveries, and challenges she faced during her research at archives in BC as well as at the Winnipeg Public Library Archives, Library and Archives Canada, and the Chicago Public Library Archives.

Cathy Converse is a number-one best-selling author with several books on the BC Bestseller List. She has been writing for thirty years and has written and co-authored six books and numerous cover stories for magazines and academic journals. She is also the former chair of Social Sciences at Camosun College and was a faculty member in the Department of Sociology. For her work in writing historical biography she has been named in *Canadian Who's Who*.
