# New at the Vancouver Public Library

### **Canadian Historical Newspapers**

Explore Canada's history through the lens of historical newspapers. Fully digitized issues of many major Canadian newspapers back to their very first issues. Contents include full runs of: Vancouver Sun, Vancouver Province, Victoria Times Colonist, Calgary Herald, Edmonton Journal, Saskatoon Star Phoenix, Regina Leader-Post, Ottawa Citizen, Globe and Mail, Windsor Star, and Montreal Gazette. Recent issues are not available in this collection, but Canadian Newsstream provides text versions of current issues. Accessible everywhere for Vancouver residents.

### **Ethnic Diversity Source**

As a complement to Academic Search Ultimate, this resource includes a wider range of publications focused on the culture and lived experience of ethnic groups in North America. In addition to articles from peer-reviewed journals and popular magazines, it also includes full-text access to relevant ebooks, biographies, and primary source documents. Accessible everywhere for VPL cardholders.

### **Great Courses on Kanopy**

For lifelong learning, stream a wide selection of lectures presented by award-winning experts and professors from respected institutions. Select up to 2 courses per 30 days. Once selected, each Great Course series can be accessed for 30 days. Up to 2 courses may be active at any time. A Kanopy account is required to view videos. Videos viewed through The Great Courses are not counted as part of the monthly 5 play credit limit in the main Kanopy site. Accessible everywhere for Vancouver residents.

A streaming collection of classic and contemporary films from around the world, including Africa, Asia, Europe, Latin America, the Caribbean, the Middle East, and North America. This resource also provides access to the library's permanent collection of films focused on Indigenous voices, culture, history, and contemporary perspectives. Accessible everywhere for VPL cardholders.

### Canadiana Héritage

Chinese Immigration Records: C.I.9 **Certificates from Vancouver and Victoria** A person of Chinese ancestry (whether born abroad or in Canada) who wished to leave Canada temporarily had to register with immigration authorities. The C.I.9 (initially called a Certificate of Leave) was issued at the port of departure, and was time-limited. When it was issued, the individual was required to surrender other identifying certificates (e.g. C.I.5, 6, 28, 30, 36). When he re-entered Canada, the C.I.9 certificate was returned to immigration authorities, stamped and filed. Original certificates deposited with immigration authorities at the time of departure were returned to the individual. The C.I.9 was used from around 1885 to 1952. These C.I.9 certificates are now available for viewing online at Canadiana Héritage.

# **Navigating Online Records in Poland** to Find Ancestors

The ability to search for birth, marriage and death records in regions now in Poland has enabled genealogy research most of us never thought possible. However, to many these resources are a perplexing maze of random searches. This presentation will provide a brief overview of two primary databases which reveal parish and civil registry records in Poland encompassing many Polish, German and Jewish residents of in the 19<sup>th</sup> – early 20<sup>th</sup> centuries: Geneteka and Metryki.Genealodzy.PL

This presentation was originally created in 2021 for members of the Society of German Genealogy in Eastern Europe as the second session of a 6-part course on navigating various online databases in Poland. A handout with links, basic word list, and suggestions of additional resources will be provided as a pdf.

The program presenter is Sigrid Pohl Perry, Ph.D. Sigrid was born in Wedel, Germany to a family whose ancestors lived in the Lubelskie province for almost a century before being resettled to the Wartheland region of northern Poland in 1940 and Hamburg in 1945. Her immediate family immigrated to Illinois in 1952 while other members of the clan homesteaded on the Alberta prairie or remained in Germany. Sigrid worked with archives and special collections at Northwestern University Library for 40 years until retiring in 2020. A member of the Society for German Genealogy in Eastern Europe (SGGEE) since 2003, Sigrid has served on the Board of Directors; been actively involved in Lublin Project indexing; and given various presentations at SGGEE Conventions. the International German Genealogy Partnership, and a local Illinois Family History Center.


Graveyards: Rosa Stewart

Fran Morrison will draw on archival images, genealogical records, newspapers, and manuscripts to describe the backgrounds, skills, interests and achievements of Black people in B.C., as well as the attitudes they historically confronted. The discussion will touch on a range of topics, including economics, employment, education, women, politics and human rights issues, while also highlighting specific archival materials that have helped Fran piece together this important history.

Fran Morrison originates from Nova Scotia, where her maternal ancestors arrived as Black Loyalists after the American War of Independence in 1783. She moved to British Columbia with her family in 1992. Fran has worked in the private and public sector for more than 25 years in project management, operations management, and contract management. She is currently a Director with BC Black History Awareness Society where she manages and oversees content research and development, fosters community partnerships, and delivers presentations on early BC Black History. Her recent work includes co-authoring Challenging Racist 'British Columbia' (2021), advising the Royal BC Museum's *Hope Meets Action* exhibition (Aug 2021-Mar 2022), and contributing to the Knowledge Network's British Columbia: An Untold Story.
