

Writing Compelling Stories About Past Lives

You've collected a cabinet full of records about your ancestors: who begot who, conflicting dates galore, family portraits, and a few surprising revelations of misdeeds and deprivation. And now you want to produce a book for family that's guaranteed not to sit on your cousin's top shelf collecting dust.

Historian/writer Jeanette Taylor will delve into the secrets of selecting compelling strands of historical information, using an understanding of what constitutes the classic forms of storytelling. "Specific details about people with dreams and obstacles is what sticks," says Taylor, who will talk about how stories trigger readers' brains. There will be a short writing exercise, so bring a notebook or laptop. Taylor will follow her presentation with a reading list for further study.

Jeanette Taylor has written four books chronicling BC coastal history, including *Tidal Passages, A History of the Discovery Islands*, which remained on the BC Bestseller list for nearly a year. Harbour Publishing will release her fifth book, *Sheltering in the Backrush, A History of Twin Islands*, this spring.

Taylor was formerly on the curatorial team at the Museum at Campbell River. She teaches fiction and nonfiction writing workshops via Zoom and is currently writing historical fiction and a nonfiction history of the Broughton Islands and Mainland inlets. She leads BC heritage sites tours aboard the historic Columbia III, for Mothership Adventures.

English Research Before 1850: Parish Registers & Wills

Parish registers are the main resource for English research prior to the census (1841) and Civil Registration (1837). With the proliferation of digitized records on the internet, this research is becoming much easier to access. Questions covered in this workshop will include:

• What information is included with baptism, marriage, and burial entries?

- Does the information differ at different periods?
- Why are Church of England registers so important for all English research?
- Are there records of other denominations?
- What other records can be used to find baptisms, marriages and burials?
- What internet sites have parish registers?

Wills can also provide genealogical information, and it is surprising who made wills in the 1700s. Wills made before 1858 were proved in church courts and there were over two hundred courts in existence. We will address:

- How can the relevant court be determined?
- Are there indexes online?
- Where can wills be found online?

Using these resources (if they have survived!), English research can be taken back as far as the late 1500s.

The grisly murder of a nurse, a crippling 1917 strike, death on the wartime battlefield, the 1918-19 flu pandemic, life on the home front – these are just some of the historic events covered in the early days of the Trail Creek News. In Printer's Devils, historian Ron Verzuh offers both a study of pioneer journalism and a social history of the smelter city of Trail as it grew into a small but prosperous community. He traces the stories of residents and their evolving attitudes, pastimes and opinions as they respond in times of economic crisis, war, labour strife and life-threatening disease against the backdrop of one of Canada's pioneer industrial centres.



Ron Verzuh holds a PhD in History from Simon Fraser University, and is the author of a book titled "Printer's Devils – The Feisty Pioneer Newspaper That Shaped the History of British Columbia's Smelter City 1895-1925", published by Caitlin Press.
